Patient survival follows patients from first transplant of this type until death. Graft survival follows individual transplants until graft failure. Counts for patient and graft survival are different because a patient may have more than one transplant for a type organ.

Survival rates are adjusted to the characteristics of transplants in year 1998. See Technical Notes for details of patient and graft survival methods.
